Plan A

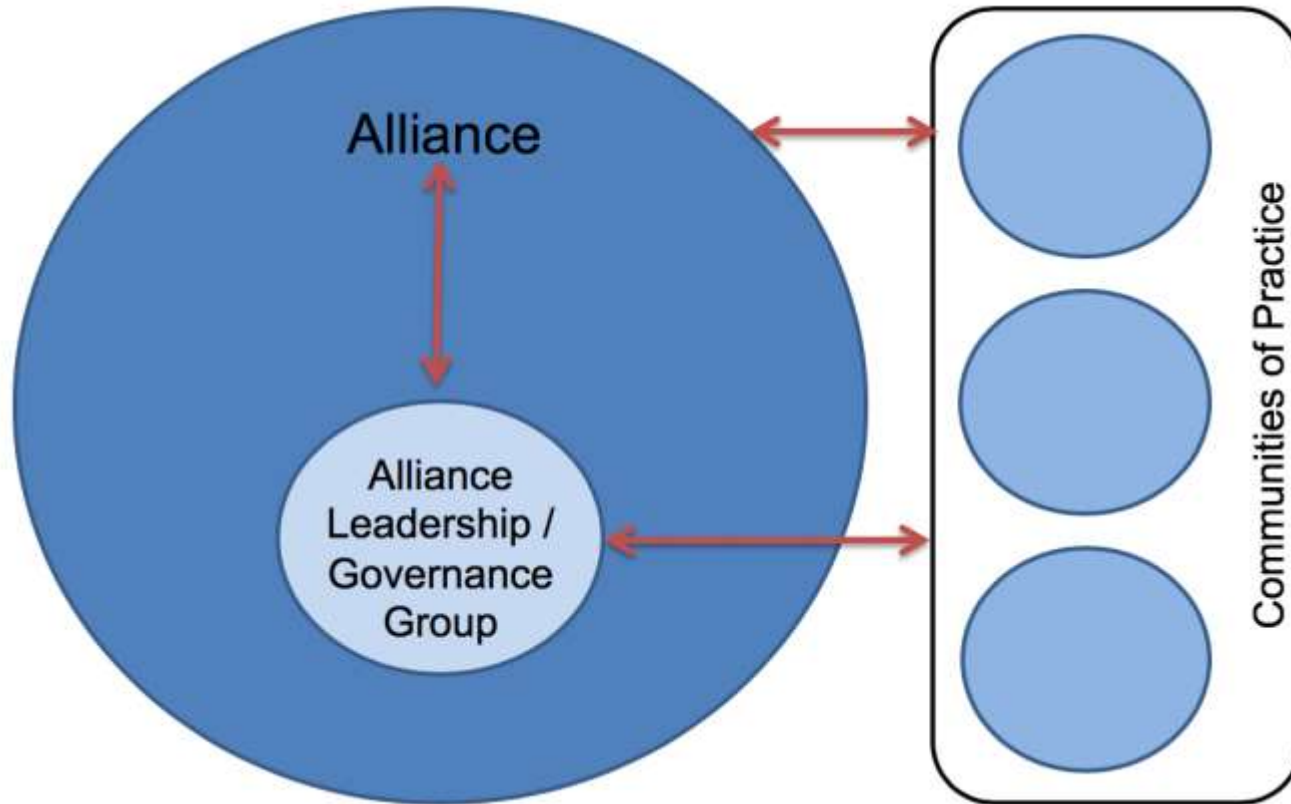
- * Chair to be decided [could this be 12 month position or rotating?]
